A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON THE NORTHERLY 3-FEET OF THE EXISTING 8-FOOT-WIDE PUBLIC UTILITY AND DRAINAGE EASEMENT, EXCEPT FOR THE WESTERLY 10-FEET, ON THE SOUTHERLY PROPERTY LINE OF 1689 PEACHBLOSSOM DRIVE, TRACT 2277, BLOCK 3, LOT 24

RECITALS: Kenneth Phillippe requests to abandon the northerly 3-feet of the existing 8-foot-wide Public Utility and Drainage Easement, except the westerly 10-feet, on the southerly property line of Tract 2277, Block 3, Lot 24.
