**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

**The Project and Project work is described as follows:**

**Design and Construction of Pima Wash Improvements**

This project had been identified as the second project within the Wash Crossing Improvement program in the FY 26 CIP for Design and Construction. This project includes converting at grade wash bed and Bank Stabilization from the Nelson Drain to Bluewater Drive.

**Construction of Kiowa Drain Wash Reach 3**

This project was identified as the number 8 priority of the top ten washes requiring improvements in the City’s Master Drainage Plan. Design was completed in FY25 and includes wash bed stabilization and bank protection, utility relocations and Army Corps Permitting as necessary. The project has been Bid and awaiting Award by City Council.

**FEMA and Floodplain Management**

This includes the cost outside consulting to assist with Flood Control Administration: ADEQ, Water Quality, MS-4 Permit and documentation, FEMA Mapping, General Floodplain Admin, Various Public Outreach, notifications and consulting and fees associated with ADEQ permit and testing associated with the City’s MS-4 Discharge Permit.

**Lake Havasu City Wash Crew and Storm Cleanup Program**

This program includes the cost of crew clean up, Engineering and Administrative Services and materials to perform regular storm clean up of streets and wash crossings.

**Wash Management Program**

This Program is identified for small wash repair projects where bank and road/wash crossing or existing drop structure repairs, or a minor drop structure is required.
