## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, CONTINUING THE DOWNTOWN ASSOCIATION PILOT PARKING PROGRAM AS TO THE PARKING IN COMMON SIGNAGE

**RECITALS,** in 2024, the City was approached by the Downtown Association requesting assistance from the City in addressing certain parking concerns. The City agreed to implement a pilot program. The Downtown Association requested additional time to pilot the parking in common signage portion of the program.

**IT IS RESOLVED** that the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, establish the Downtown Association Pilot Parking Program as follows:

- 1. Parking In Common Signage: Approved signage as shown on the attached Exhibit A may be posted at the expense of the property owner within improved and well-maintained Parking-In-Common areas within the Downtown Association boundaries per the Master Parking in Common Plan (PIC-95-004). Signs may only be posted on one-third (1/3) of the available parking spots per property, but no less than one per property. Posting of signs in accordance with this Resolution will not be in violation of City Code Chapter 14.04 for the duration of the Pilot Program.
- 2. <u>Pilot Program</u>: This Downtown Association Pilot Parking Program will commence on January 1, 2026, and continue for one year. The Program will terminate at the end of the year, unless any portion of the Program is otherwise authorized to continue.
