A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE FY 25 COMMUNITY POLICING DEVELOPMENT MICROGRANTS PROGRAM, FOR OFFICER RECRUITMENT AND UPLIFTING THE IMAGE OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT PROFESSION, AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ACTIVITIES FUNDED BY THE GRANTS

RECITALS: Lake Havasu City ("City") is authorized under Arizona Revised Statutes § 11-952 to enter into intergovernmental agreements. Community Policing Development funds are used to develop the capacity of law enforcement to implement community policing strategies by providing guidance on promising practices through the development and testing of innovative strategies, building knowledge about effective practices and outcomes, and supporting new, creative approaches to preventing crime and promoting safe communities. The Police Department desires to apply for funding in two categories: (1) to aid in officer recruitment and (2) to aid in uplifting the image of the law enforcement profession efforts.

IT IS RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City approve the submission of a grant applications to the United States Department of Justice, Community Policing Development Microgrants Program; and authorize the City Manager to execute the grant agreements, deliver all documents necessary to carry out the terms and intent of the grants, and take all steps necessary to implement and complete the activities funded and required by the grants, subject to necessary review and approval by the City Attorney.
