**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY,
MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF
INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON THE EASTERLY 5-FEET OF THE
EXISTING 10-FOOT-WIDE PUBLIC UTILITY AND DRAINAGE EASEMENT ON
THE WESTERLY PROPERTY LINE OF TRACT 116, BLOCK 9, LOT 11, EXCLUDING
THE REAR MOST 10-FEET**

RECITALS: Leslie Muchmore requests to abandon the easterly 5-feet of the existing 10-foot-wide Public Utility and Drainage Easement on the westerly property line of Tract 116, Block 9, Lot 11, excluding the rear most 10-feet. The Development Services Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments, and no utilities will be affected by the abandonment of the property.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the easterly 5-feet of the existing 10-foot-wide Public Utility and Drainage Easement on the westerly property line of Tract 116, Block 9, Lot 11, excluding the rear most 10-feet, is abandoned as described in the attached Exhibits “A” and “B” because this easement is no longer necessary for City purposes.
