

RESOLUTION NO. 18-3222

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON THE WESTERLY 5-FOOT BY APPROXIMATELY 100-FOOT PORTION OF THE 10-FOOT PUBLIC UTILITY AND DRAINAGE EASEMENT ALONG THE EASTERN PROPERTY LINE OF TRACT 2157, BLOCK 13, LOT 8

RECITALS: Walter & Cassie Parker request to abandon the westerly 5-foot by approximately 100-foot portion of the 10-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easement along the eastern property line of Tract 2157, Block 13, Lot 8. The Community Investment Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments and no utilities will be affected by the abandonment of the property.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the westerly 5-foot by approximately 100-foot portion of the 10-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easement along the eastern property line of Tract 2157, Block 13, Lot 8, is abandoned as described in the attached Exhibits “A” and “B,” because this easement is no longer necessary for City purposes.
