

RESOLUTION NO. 26-3896

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON THE SOUTHWESTERLY 3-FEET OF THE EXISTING 8-FOOT-WIDE PUBLIC UTILITY AND DRAINAGE EASEMENT ON THE NORTHEASTERLY PROPERTY LINE OF 1901 CHIP DRIVE, TRACT 2302, BLOCK 6, LOT 1

RECITALS: Evans Family Trust requests to abandon the southwesterly 3-feet of the existing 8-foot-wide Public Utility and Drainage Easement on the northeasterly property line of 1901 Chip Drive, Tract 2302, Block 6, Lot 1. The Development Services Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments, and no utilities will be affected by the abandonment of the property.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the southwesterly 3-feet of the existing 8-foot-wide Public Utility and Drainage Easement on the northeasterly property line of 1901 Chip Drive, Tract 2302, Block 6, Lot 1, is abandoned as described in the attached Exhibits “A” and “B,” because this easement is no longer necessary for City purposes.
