

RESOLUTION NO. 19-3366

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON THE ENTIRE 10-FOOT BY 65-FOOT AND THE ENTIRE 10-FOOT BY 95-FOOT PUBLIC UTILITY AND DRAINAGE EASEMENTS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY PROPERTY LINES OF TRACT 2319, BLOCK 3, LOT 11

RECITALS: Mike Ward requests to abandon the entire 10-foot by 65-foot and the entire 10-foot by 95-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easements located along the westerly property lines of Tract 2319, Block 3, Lot 11. The Development Services Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments and no utilities will be affected by the abandonment of the property.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the entire 10-foot by 65-foot and the entire 10-foot by 95-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easements located along the westerly property lines of Tract 2319, Block 3, Lot 11, are abandoned as described in the attached Exhibits “A” and “B,” because these easements are no longer necessary for City purposes.
