**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY,
MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF
INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON THE EASTERLY 10-FOOT BY 20-
FOOT PORTION OF A 10-FOOT BY 50-FOOT PUBLIC UTILITY, DRAINAGE, AND
ANCHOR EASEMENT ALONG THE SOUTHERLY PROPERTY LINE OF TRACT
2224, BLOCK 6, LOT 15**

RECITALS: A.P.L. Surveying, Inc., requests to abandon the easterly 10-foot by 20-foot portion of a 10-foot by 50-foot Public Utility, Drainage, and Anchor Easement along the southerly property line of Tract 2224, Block 6, Lot 15. The Community Investment Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the easterly 10-foot by 20-foot portion of a 10-foot by 50-foot Public Utility, Drainage, and Anchor Easement along the southerly property line of Tract 2224, Block 6, Lot 15, is abandoned as described in the attached Exhibits "A" and "B," because this easement is no longer necessary for City purposes.
