RECITALS: June & Steve Parsons request to abandon the easterly 5-foot portion of the 10-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easement lying easterly, parallel and adjoining the common boundary of Lot 33 and Lot 4, near the south property line of Tract 106, Block 2, Lot 33. The Community Investment Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments.
