**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY,  
MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE MOHAVE COUNTY MULTI-  
JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN  
2016**

**RECITALS:** The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all local, county, tribal, and state governments to have a FEMA approved hazard mitigation plan to be eligible for federal disaster mitigation funds. A planning team comprised of representatives from various Mohave County governments reviewed and updated the 2010 Mohave County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. This mitigation planning process identifies natural hazards, assesses the vulnerability and risks posed by those hazards, and establishes goals, actions, and projects to mitigate the associated risks.

**IT IS RESOLVED** that the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, adopt the 2016 Mohave County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
