Lowest Responsive Bidder- FNF Construction, Inc.

I have recently performed a review of the contract documents, references, contractor's license, and contractor's surety for the above-referenced bidder. The following information summarizes my findings:

All reports from FNF Construction, Inc.'s project references have included good workmanship, good working relationships, completing work on time, and no cost overruns or change orders on the contractor's behalf.

FNF Construction, Inc. has a Class A Arizona contractor's license, which is the correct license for this work. I verified with the Registrar of Contractors and found that their license is in good standing with no complaints against them.

FNF Construction, Inc. maintains surety through Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, which is listed with the FMS, US Treasury Department for underwriting ability in Arizona.

FNF Construction, Inc. had the lowest responsive bid, at \$1,750,422.00. With these findings, I recommend that the base bid for the Wash Stabilization Improvements Bid Package #1be awarded to FNF Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$1,750,422.00.
