

ORDINANCE NO. 17-1173

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, REPEALING LAKE HAVASU CITY CODE SECTION 11.06.080, TRAILS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That Lake Havasu City Code Section 11.06.080, Trails Advisory Committee, is repealed in its entirety.

~~§ 11.06.080 TRAILS ADVISORY COMMITTEE~~

- ~~A. There is established a Trails Advisory Committee, a subcommittee of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. The Parks and Recreation Board will oversee the Trails Advisory Committee, which will report directly to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board unless directed otherwise by the City Council.~~
- ~~B. The members of the Trails Advisory Committee will be appointed by the Mayor and City Council. The Committee shall consist of nine (9) regular members. Member must be residents of Lake Havasu City.~~
- ~~C. Ex Officio members of the Trails Advisory Committee may include the Aquatics/Recreation Manager, a Maintenance Services Division staff member.~~
- ~~D. Regular members will serve two year terms commencing the first day of July and shall end on the thirtieth day of June. Each regular member must serve until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.~~
- ~~E. Members of the Trails Advisory Committee shall receive no compensation for their services as Committee members.~~
- ~~F. The absence from three (3) consecutive regular meetings of the Trails Advisory Committee by any member without the consent of the Chairperson will be deemed to constitute a resignation of the member, and the member's position will be deemed vacant.~~
- ~~G. The Trails Advisory Committee shall have the following powers and duties:~~
 - ~~1. To set a time for regular meetings, which may be held at least once each month.~~
 - ~~2. To provide input, advice, and recommendations to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board on matters of pertinence and interest related to the development of trails in and around Lake Havasu City.~~

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
