A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, REVISING RESOLUTION NO. 10-2484 TO AMEND WASTEWATER FEES FOR REUSE OF TREATED EFFLUENT EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017

RECITALS: In 2010 by Resolution No. 10-2484, the City Council established a wastewater fee for reuse of treated effluent. The City desires to amend this fee. The estimated cost to treat the effluent for reuse and delivery is approximately \$227.70 per acre-foot and the cost of disposal using the vadose wells with the current Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) monitoring requirements is substantially higher.

The wastewater fee for commercial reuse of treated effluent is tied to market rates in similarly situated communities, the City desires to encourage reuse of treated effluent to increase the greenspace in the City and recreational opportunities for residents and visitors by pricing effluent at closer to the actual cost to treat and deliver the water.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the Treated Effluent for Reuse Charges for Commercial Use and Governmental Use are amended as follows:

Treated Effluent for Reuse Charge - COMMERCIAL USE	\$228.00 per acre foot
Treated Effluent for Reuse Charge - GOVERNMENTAL USE	\$117.61 per acre foot
