**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY,
MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF
INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON THE NORTHERLY 5-FOOT BY 85-
FOOT PORTION OF THE 10-FOOT BY 85-FOOT PUBLIC UTILITY AND DRAINAGE
EASEMENT ALONG THE SOUTHERLY PROPERTY LINE OF TRACT 2227, BLOCK
3, LOT 14**

RECITALS: Shauna Martin requests to abandon the northerly 5-foot by 85-foot portion of the 10-foot by 85-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easement along the southerly property line of Tract 2227, Block 3, Lot 14. The Community Investment Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments and no utilities will be affected by the abandonment of the property.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the northerly 5-foot by 85-foot portion of the 10-foot by 85-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easement along the southerly property line of Tract 2227, Block 3, Lot 14, is abandoned as described in the attached Exhibits "A" and "B," because this easement is no longer necessary for City purposes.




