

RESOLUTION NO. 17-3145

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY, MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO ABANDON A PORTION OF THE 20-FOOT BY 125-FOOT PUBLIC UTILITY AND DRAINAGE EASEMENT WHICH RUNS EAST AND WEST THROUGH PARCEL 11-A OF TRACT 2144, BLOCK 2

RECITALS: Robert Kuhn requests to abandon a portion of the 20-foot by 125-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easement which runs east and west through Parcel 11-A of Tract 2144, Block 2, per Parcel Plat recorded in Book 30 of Parcel Plats, Page 52. The Community Investment Department investigated the request and received no objections from City departments and no utilities will be affected by the abandonment of the property.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, that the portion of the 20-foot by 125-foot Public Utility and Drainage Easement which runs east and west through Parcel 11-A of Tract 2144, Block 2, per Parcel Plat recorded in Book 30 of Parcel Plats, Page 52, is abandoned as described in the attached Exhibits "A" and "B," because this easement is no longer necessary for City purposes.
