Page 11, Article 7, 7.2 A: revise as follows [Leave time shall be transferred into the Association Leave Time bank by utilizing the appropriate PTO transfer form and shall be allowed to be carried over up to a maximum amount not to exceed 588 672 hours (the maximum PTO accrual for a fire shift employee). There shall be no time limit on the use of hours transferred under this section.]

Page 15, Article 10, 10.2: revise as follows: [Upon completion of the salary survey, results shall be forwarded to the City Council & Association President as part of the budget process, along with a formal recommendation of action by City staff. A copy of the salary survey will also be provided to the Association.]
