Lowest Responsive Bidder – Premier Backhoe, Inc.

We have completed a review of contract documents, references, contractor's license, and contractor's surety for the above-referenced bidder. The following information summarizes our findings:

Premier Backhoe, Inc. has completed several projects similar to this one and has experience working with government agencies in the State of Arizona including Lake Havasu City and nearby cities such as Bullhead City. The reports from the contractor's past project references were overwhelmingly positive. The references reported good workmanship, good working relationships, work being completed on time, and no cost overruns or change orders on the contractor's behalf.

Premier Backhoe, Inc. has a "KA" license, which is the correct license for this work. Verification with the Registrar of Contractors found that their General Engineering License is in good standing with no complaints against them.

Premier Backhoe, Inc. maintains surety through American Contractor's Indemnity Company, which is listed with the FMS US Treasury Department for underwriting ability in Arizona.

The budget for this project is \$150,000. The Engineer's Estimate was \$140,448.99 for the base bid plus force account. The low bid came in at \$143,448.99 for the base bid plus force account.
