FUNDING SOURCE:

Grant

PURPOSE:

Ratify the submission of a grant application with the Department of Homeland Security for the purchase of new self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA), commonly referred to as air packs.

BACKGROUND:

The primary goal of the Assistance of Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program is to meet the firefighting and emergency response needs of fire departments, by allowing them to obtain critically needed equipment, protective gear, and other resources needed to protect the public and emergency personnel from fire and related hazards.

COMMUNITY IMPACT:

The Department of Homeland Security's AFG Program's funding would enhance the safety of the public and firefighters and to provide support for emergency responders.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Grant funds in the amount of \$784,215, with matching funds of \$78,421.

Matching funds are included in the budget for this fiscal year (299.2701.402.8027, Grant Matching Funds, \$85,000).

SUGGESTED MOTION:
