PURPOSE:

Adopt resolution authorizing submittal of an application for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds for a State Special Project (SSP) in the amount of \$300,000 to be used for housing rehabilitation for eligible, owner occupied, single family residences, located within the city limits and administration of the program.

BACKGROUND:

CDBG funds are administered by the Arizona Department of Housing. Staff is preparing to apply for this grant to assist with housing rehabilitation of eligible, owner occupied, single family residences, located within the city limits.

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COMMUNITY IMPACT:

The adoption of this resolution publicizes the community's commitment to extend the life of affordable homes for eligible, owner occupied, single family residences, located within the city limits.

FISCAL IMPACT:
