# **SUBJECT:**

Adopt Resolution No. 17-3166 Approving and Authorizing the Police Chief to Execute a Peace Officer Training Fund Grant Agreement with the Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training (AZ POST) Board for the Operation of the Western Arizona Law Enforcement Training Academy (WALETA)

### **FUNDING SOURCE:**

Grant

#### **PURPOSE:**

Approve and authorize the Police Chief to execute a grant agreement with AZ POST for the operation of WALETA.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Lake Havasu City has acted in a fiduciary capacity for WALETA since the inception of the program in 2007. A similar grant agreement was entered into with AZ POST in 2015 (AZ POST Contract #2015-001) at a funding amount of \$100,000 annually for five (5) years; however, budgetary constraints are forcing the cancellation of that agreement, resulting in a lesser annual amount.

#### **COMMUNITY IMPACT:**

The reduction in annual funding from AZ POST will reduce the opportunity for future improvements at the WALETA facility but will not negatively impact the operations of the academy.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Funding in the amount of \$75,000 will be received annually for a period of five (5) years beginning the first quarter of 2017 (between July 1 and September 30). The reduction in annual revenue will be met with a corresponding reduction in expenses and/or revenue from an alternative source such as RICO or MAGNET funds contributed by Western Arizona Law Enforcement Association participating agencies.
